

Website Terms and Conditions - Teralba Lakesiders Fishing Club

1. About these Terms

These Terms and Conditions apply to your use of the Teralba Lakesiders Fishing Club website (the **Website**).

Teralba Lakesiders Fishing Club (**Club, we, us or our**) is a recreational fishing club operated primarily by volunteers in New South Wales.

By using the Website, you agree to these Terms and Conditions.

2. Purpose of the Website

The Website provides general information about the Club and its activities and allows interested persons to download a Club membership form.

The Website does not process membership applications, payments or other financial transactions online.

Downloading a membership form does not make you a member of the Club and does not guarantee that an application for membership will be accepted. Membership is governed separately by the Club's applicable rules, constitution and membership procedures.

3. Information on the Website

We aim to keep information on the Website reasonably accurate and current. However, the Website is maintained on behalf of a volunteer-run organisation and information may occasionally be incomplete, out of date or contain errors.

Information on the Website is provided for general information only.

Where information on the Website differs from the Club's constitution, rules, official notices or other governing documents, the applicable official Club document prevails.

4. Fishing and Safety Information

Any information on the Website concerning fishing, waterways, boating, weather, safety, fishing rules, bag or size limits or similar matters is general information only.

Fishing and boating laws, restrictions and conditions can change. You are responsible for checking current requirements and conditions with the relevant government or regulatory authority before fishing, boating or participating in an activity.

You remain responsible for your own safety and for deciding whether an activity is suitable for you.

5. Membership Forms

The Club may make a membership application form available for download through the Website.

You are responsible for ensuring that you use the current version of the form and provide accurate information when completing it.

Instructions for submitting a completed membership form will be set out on the form or otherwise provided by the Club.

6. Contact Details Collected Through the Website

When you download or request a membership form, we may ask you to provide information such as your name and email address.

We use this information so that the Club Secretary or another authorised Club volunteer can contact you in relation to your interest in the Club, the membership form or membership enquiries.

Our handling of personal information collected through the Website is explained in our Privacy Policy.

7. Acceptable Use

You must not use the Website:

- for an unlawful purpose;
- in a way that interferes with the operation or security of the Website;
- to attempt to gain unauthorised access to the Website or its systems;
- to introduce malicious software or harmful code; or
- to impersonate another person or provide deliberately false information.

8. Intellectual Property

Unless otherwise stated, material on the Website is owned by or used with the permission of the Club.

You may view, download and print Website material for your personal, non-commercial use, including downloading a membership form for the purpose for which it is provided.

You must not reproduce or use Website material for a commercial purpose without the Club's permission, unless permitted by law.

9. Third-Party Websites

The Website may contain links to websites operated by government agencies, fishing organisations, community organisations or other third parties.

These links are provided for convenience only. The Club does not control third-party websites and is not responsible for their content, availability, security or privacy practices.

10. Availability of the Website

We do not guarantee that the Website will always be available, uninterrupted, secure or free from errors.

As the Club is operated by volunteers, Website enquiries, updates and technical issues may not always be dealt with immediately.

11. Liability

To the extent permitted by law, the Club is not responsible for loss or damage arising from reliance on general information published on the Website or from the Website being unavailable or containing an error.

Nothing in these Terms excludes, restricts or modifies any right or remedy that cannot lawfully be excluded, restricted or modified.

12. Changes to these Terms

We may update these Terms and Conditions from time to time.

The current version will be published on the Website with the date it was last updated.

13. Governing Law

These Terms and Conditions are governed by the laws of New South Wales, Australia.

1. About this Privacy Policy

Terlaba Lakesiders Fishing Club (**Club, we, us or our**) is a recreational fishing club operated primarily by volunteers in New South Wales.

We respect the privacy of people who visit our website (**Website**) and provide personal information to us through it.

This Privacy Policy explains how we handle personal information collected through the Website.

2. Information We Collect

The Website has limited functions and does not process payments or other financial transactions.

When you download or request a Club membership form, we may collect:

- your name;
- your email address; and
- any other information you voluntarily provide with an enquiry.

Depending on how the Website is hosted, some technical information may also be collected automatically, such as an IP address, browser information or basic Website usage information.

3. Why We Collect Your Information

If you provide your name or email address when downloading or requesting a membership form, we collect that information primarily so that the Club Secretary or another authorised Club volunteer can contact you about:

- the membership form;
- your interest in joining the Club;
- how to submit a membership application;
- membership enquiries; or
- related Club information that is reasonably relevant to your enquiry.

We will not use contact details collected through the membership-form download process for unrelated commercial marketing.

4. Providing Your Information

You do not have to provide personal information to browse general information on the Website.

If the Website requires an email address before a membership form can be downloaded, you will need to provide that information to use that particular function.

5. Who Has Access to Your Information

Personal information collected through the Website will ordinarily be accessible only to the Club Secretary and any other Club committee member or volunteer who reasonably needs access to deal with your enquiry or membership interest.

We ask Club volunteers who handle personal information to use it only for Club purposes.

6. Disclosure of Information

We do not sell or rent personal information.

We may disclose personal information where:

- you have asked or authorised us to do so;
- it is reasonably necessary to deal with your enquiry or membership interest;
- a service provider requires access to information to operate or maintain the Website or Club communications; or
- disclosure is required or authorised by law.

7. Website and Email Service Providers

The Website, email service or online forms may be operated using third-party service providers.

As a result, information submitted through the Website may be stored or processed using systems operated by those providers, including systems located outside Australia.

We take reasonable steps appropriate to the nature of the Club and the information it holds when selecting and using services that handle personal information.

8. Keeping Information Secure

We take reasonable steps appropriate to a small volunteer-run organisation to protect personal information from misuse, loss and unauthorised access or disclosure.

However, no internet transmission, email system or electronic storage system can be guaranteed to be completely secure.

9. How Long We Keep Information

We will generally keep contact information collected through the membership-form download process only for as long as it is reasonably required to respond to you, follow up your membership interest and maintain appropriate Club records.

Information that becomes part of an actual membership application or Club membership record may be retained separately in accordance with the Club's record-keeping requirements.

10. Access and Correction

If you would like to know what personal information the Club holds about you through the Website, or believe that information we hold is incorrect, please contact the Club Secretary.

We will deal with reasonable requests as soon as practicable, having regard to the Club's volunteer administration.

11. Cookies and Website Analytics

The Website may use cookies or similar technologies that are necessary for the Website to operate.

If the Club uses an analytics service, that service may also collect information about Website visits, such as pages viewed, approximate location, device or browser type and the time of a visit.

The precise information collected will depend on the Website hosting and analytics services used by the Club.

12. Links to Other Websites

The Website may contain links to third-party websites.

The Club is not responsible for the privacy practices of those websites. You should review the privacy information provided by the operator of any third-party website you visit.

13. Changes to this Policy

We may update this Privacy Policy from time to time, including if the way the Website operates or collects information changes.

The current version will be published on the Website with its last updated date.
